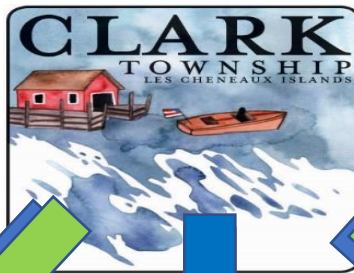

WHAT HAVE WE DONE!

- Hill Island Causeway Bridge renovations and Hydrology project to enhance water flow at Flower Bay.
- Cedarville Harbor project completed.
- Short Term Rental Ordinance in place.
- Marijuana Ordinance in place
- Broadband at all Township facilities.
- Additional security cameras installed at all Township facilities.
- PickleBall courts at Heritage Park (4 pickleball and 1 tennis court).
- Purchase of a new jetter and a new Backhoe loader for the DPW.
- Sinkhole repaired at Beach and Grove Streets.
- Enhanced aeration system at the Sewer Lagoons.
- New bathroom facilities at Heritage Park.
- Story Book Trail at the Heritage Park Trail.
- Purchase of a new rescue/fireboat expected to be completed in August of 2022.
- Cedarville Streetscape project to enhance lighting and replace trees in the Summer of 2022 – Beautification Committee.

WHAT ARE WE DOING!

- The Neal House purchase to be incorporated with the expansion of Hessel Marina. Purchase offer has been accepted. Fundraising for the DNR Trust Fund grant match campaign is ongoing.
- Replace the Clark Township Fire and Ambulance Hall – future plan.
- The new Peek-A-Boo Trail is open for hiking and a grant has been awarded for the future Fat Tire Bike Trails.
- The Township is now the FBO for the airport and a pilot group has been exploring ways to enhance our airport.
- Bike Trail signage from Cedarville through Hessel and Cedarville, and fundraising for Islandview to 4 Mile Block constructing segment along M-134.
- Leopold Landing improvements including outhouse and kayak dock.
- Lakeside Road at M-134 will get a new street light.
- Lakeside Road widening and repaving project (bike and pedestrian lane) is in the works.

AND...STILL MORE GOING ON...WHAT ARE WE DOING!

- Kayak dock at Cedarville Harbor is expected to be completed this Summer.
- We applied for a state revolving fund grant to replace all grinder pumps and update control panels in the Township.
- Planning to widen Meridian Street shoulder from the Harbor to the Boat School in Cedarville.
- The Weston Trail Project will enhance the Portage Trail from the launch ramp to Cedarville EZ Mart at M-134.
- Future crib dock at Cedarville Harbor is also in the works to complete kayak dock.
- Three municipal parking lots are being developed downtown for Marina and snowmobile trailer parking. (2 in Hessel and 1 in Cedarville), plus snowmobile lot across from Snowmobile Club.
- Seeking two individuals to join the ambulance crew.
