## IX. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

**GENERAL:** Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Bureau of Construction Codes. All installations shall be in conformance with the State Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector shall be provided on the permit form. When ready for inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the **job location and permit number**.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.

WHERE TO SUBMIT APPLICATION: The Bureau of Construction Codes is responsible for code enforcement in units of government throughout the state which have no local program and for all state owned buildings. Permit applications for state issued permits should be sent to the address on the front side of this application. If you are not sure whether a state permit or a local permit is appropriate, contact our office or you local building inspector. Questions regarding state issued permits may be directed to the Office of Management Services, Permits Sections at (517)-241-9313.

Code questions may be directed to the Electrical Division at (517)-241-9320.
